Recently Implemented Rules BODIO KODOO

Last week, we had another three great propositions up to vote. Prop 307, *The Funniest Proposal In Nomic* by player and admin Crorem, passed in a 12 to 1 vote. Players now have the four humors, sanguine, choleric, melancholic, and phlegmatic. Currently, players have a 0 quantity of each, but future props may seek to alter their amount. When asked about its passing, Crorem had this to say. "I am pleased with the near-unanimous passing of Proposal 307. When creating the proposal, I envisioned a system where players had to play a careful balancing act with their humors—perhaps if they invested in one minigame more heavily than another, they would become Imbalanced and begin to suffer game penalties. It is my expectation and my hope that the system of humors will see further additions and mechanics as the game progresses."

Prop 308, *Office Hours* by player .bananafanta, passed in a 12 to 1 vote. Players are now encouraged to meet on Tuesdays from 7pm-10pm CTD, Saturdays from 2pm-5pm CDT, and on Sundays from 11am to 1pm CDT. On Tuesday, our first office hours commenced. Prop 310 is by Nom Times CEO, Bobo Kobo. This proposal seeks to trademark the name of the company and paper. As we said in our last issue, we here at the Nom times are in heavy support of this proposal and hope to see good results.
