Recently, Judgment was called in regards to the now repealed rule 315. Said rule required plays to declare the earth as flat when mentioning it. When players did not declare the earth was flat, other players could call them out with an emoji. Once a player received 5 of the flat-earth emoji, they'd have to apologize. Judgment was called by Crorem who begged the question "what counts as an apology and what the time expectations for apologies are per Rule 315." Alec was chosen as judge and ruled that players Fenris and Dawndishsoap87 did not apologize for their transgressions during the 48 hour time window, and therefore, until rule 315 was repealed they counted as inactive. Their votes during the time they were inactive were voided. At the top of the turn, prop 318 by thorax passed and repealed 315, rendering fenris and dawndishsoap87 active again.

Current Proposals BODO KODO

In this new, temporally reformed state, the way that proposals work is a little different. Instead of having three props up at a time, only one is up at a time. With the upcoming schedule coming for The Nom Times, current proposals will only refer to proposals in the main queue starting with our next issue.

There are currently 10 proposals in the queue and one proposal on deck.

Baegll's proposal, *Infamous Abstention*, would cause players not voting to lose 1 fame. This includes all players who do not send a yay, nay, or abstention vote. This does not include inactive players because they are unable to vote.

Ian's proposal, *Nomic of the Clock*, assigns a fruit to players each day at a random time. Players may guess their fruit 10 times. Guessing their fruit within the limit causes the player to gain one unit of their given fruit. Players who do not successfully guess their fruit may throw a banana at another player. A d8 is rolled to determine if the banana hits. Players who are hit become rotten and cannot guess their fruit. Players who are rotten gain 1 rot, and once they have gained 15 rot they are in Rot Girl Winter.

Jonah's proposal, *A Humorless Rule*, halves the number of fame an imbalanced player gains from any given action.

JTFR is still proposing to "make this a chat room."

Skeen and Beanguzzlr are still proposing to ban Alec.

Alec's Proposal, *Goose Master*, created a new subset of rules called Goose Rules. Two players would be chosen each week to either create new goose rules to replace goose rules or to not do anything at all. There can only be two goose rules at a time, and their ruleset gains a new numbering system. Goose rules remain in effect until they are replaced. Bobo Kobo's proposal is an amendment to their previously passed rule to create clarity on the Freelance Journalist pool as well as to alter the release schedule to Mondays. Fenris's proposal would create two groups, publishers and celebrities. To be a publisher, a player must post their own created media each week. Publishers gain fame by posting their media. If a publisher mentions another player, that player gains fame at the publisher's discretion. Celebrities are players who are a part of a publisher's media. To maintain their status, they must be within a piece of media each week. When a celebrity is posted in the media, the amount of fame they gain from fame rules is doubled. Dawndishsoap87's proposal, *Establishment of the HR Department*, creates an HR department where players can have arguments mediated or can have counseling sessions. On deck is *Spieltag: Pt. I* by Crorem. This proposal

Recently Implemented Rules BODO KODO
